The tastings will be presented immediately before Florida Grand Opera's 7:30 p.m. performances of one of the greatest comic operas ever produced: Gioachino Rossini's 'The Barber of Seville.'

'The Barber of Seville,' which southflorida.com raves is a 'delightfully profligate production of Rossini's wildly popular, 200-year-old comic opera,' traces the adventures of handsome young Count Almaviva as he spots the lovely Rosina and courts her in spite of her jealous guardian's attempts to thwart him. Of course, he would never have succeeded without help from that crafty Figaro, who is much, much more than just a barber.

He will present a guided tasting of two Spanish wines (one sparkling wine and one red wine), as well as a PowerPoint with illustrative slides and audio examples.
